Before joining the Kansas State faculty, she taught at Norman North High School in Norman, Oklahoma and San José State University.

She is the past-president of the Southwestern Region of the American Choral Directors Association and served as an International Conducting Exchange Fellow to Kenya in 2019. She serves as a member of the Kansas State University Faculty Senate.
